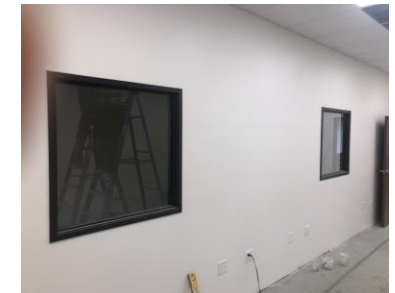

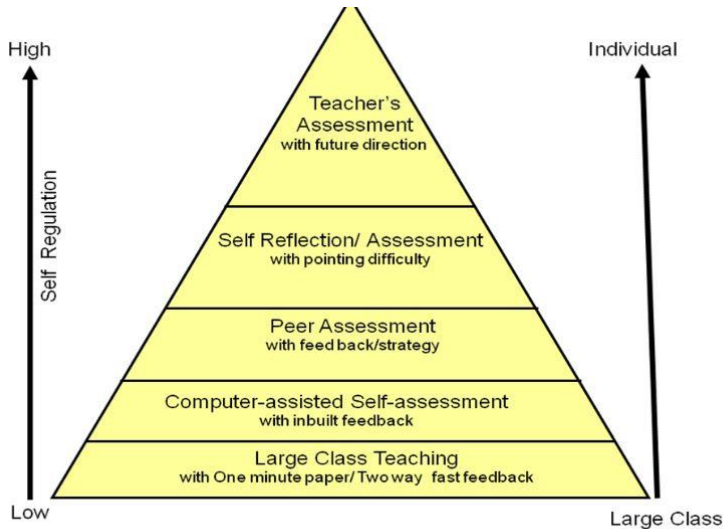
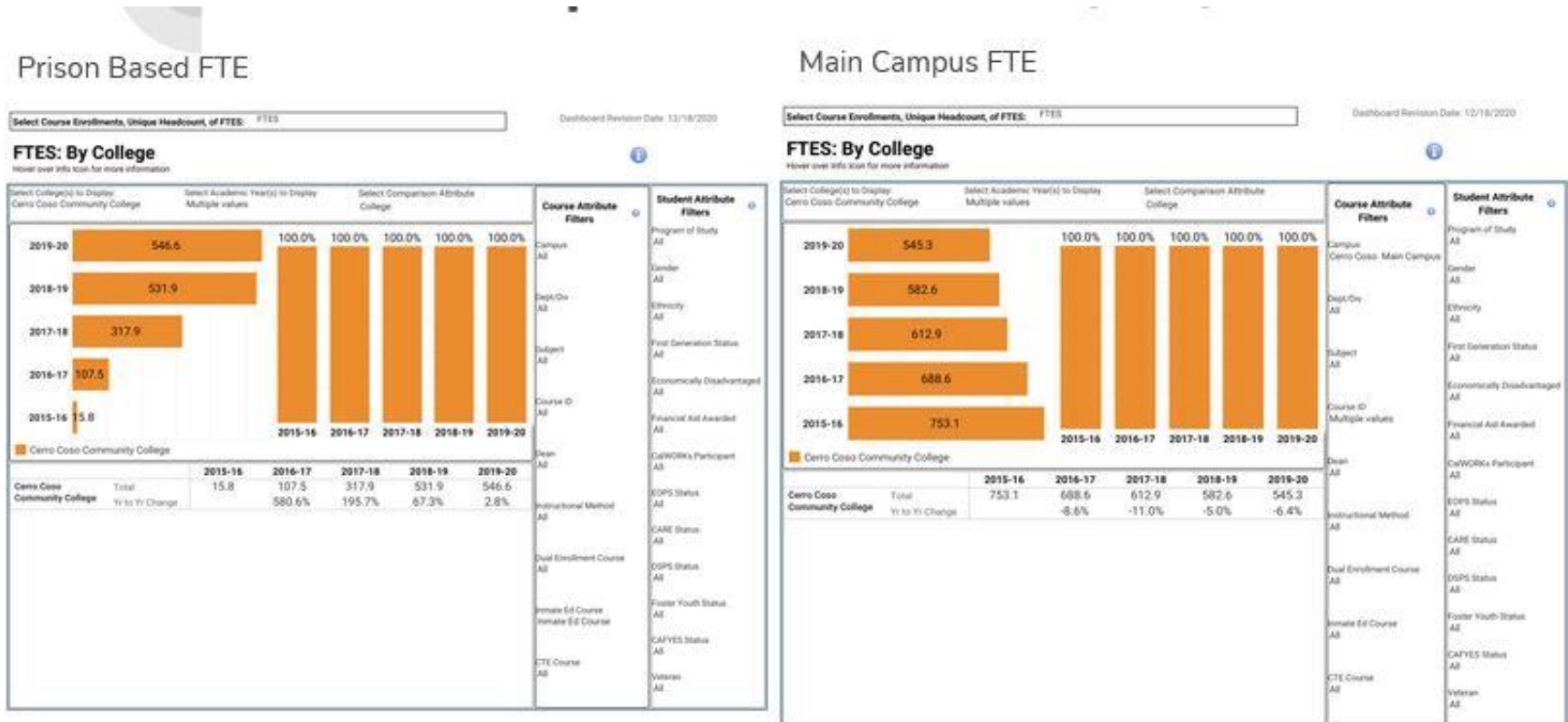


Figure 1 A model formative assessment strategy

First meeting of the Spring Semester – February 9, 2021

## Governor's January budget proposal

- May revise and approved budget may look different
- Few highlights of the proposal
  - Funding \$1.13B of the \$1.45B deferrals from 2020-21
  - Continued funding of PERS/STRS reductions as outlined in 2020-21
  - Funding 1.5% COLA on SCFF elements
  - One-time funding for programs such as emergency financial assistance to students, OER, student retention/re-enrollment, basic student needs (housing, food insecurity, etc.)
  - Expectations regarding maintaining a 10% increase in online courses compared to 2018-19 and actional plans to close equity gaps – both in order to receive COLA funding
